On the Home Screen click on "Settings"

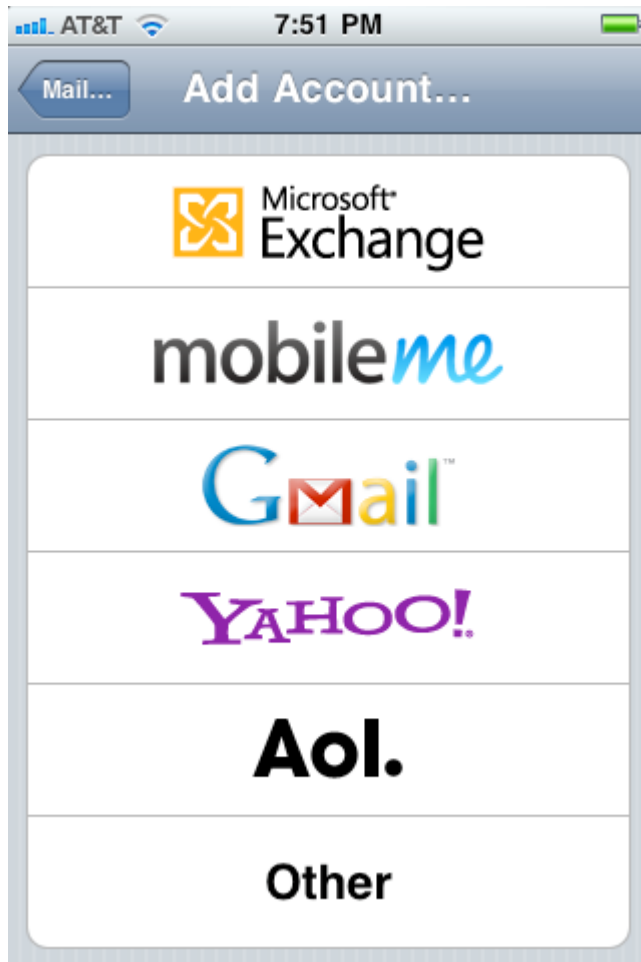


Click on Mail, Contacts, Calendars

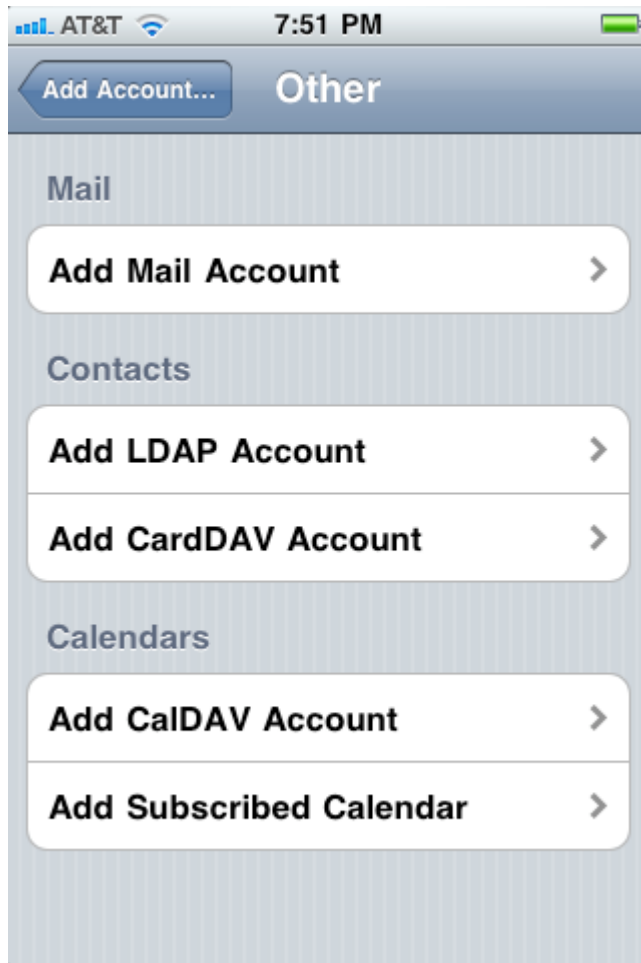


On the next screen select “Add Account”



Click on "Add Mail Account"



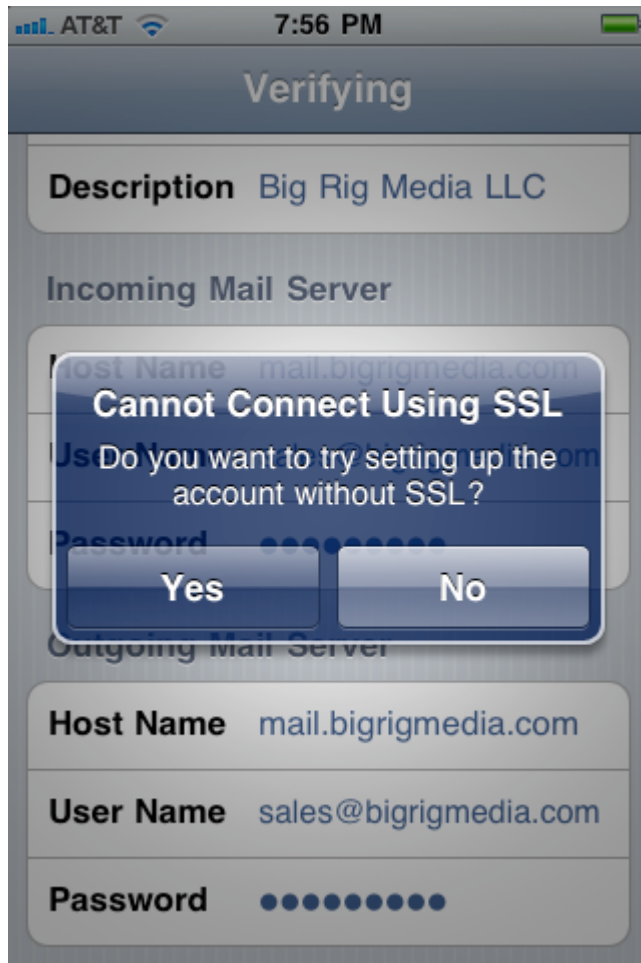

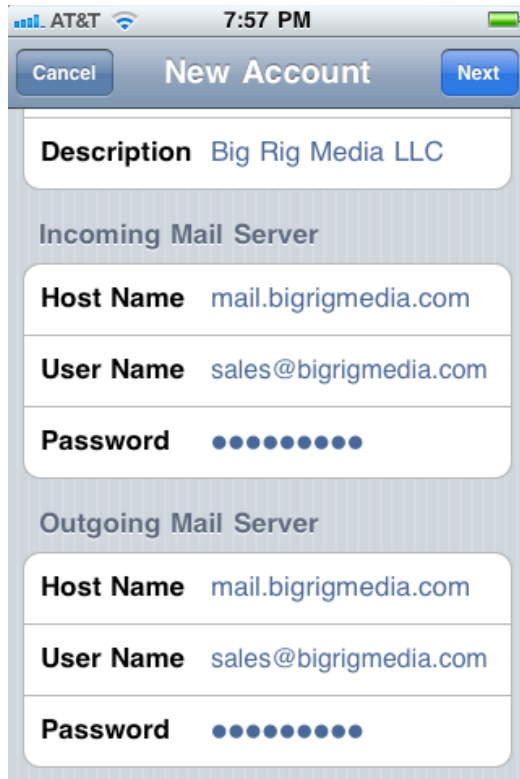
